Last Call for Proxy Ballots

The Chairman, Teresa Babb, made a last call for Proxy Ballots (on Elections, Budget &

Assessment, and approval of 2 proxy votes that affect the By-laws). There were <u>no</u> communities that indicated their proxy votes would be submitted at this time. No additional proxy votes were submitted. The Assembly Elections Chair, Valerie Mehl and J.B. Taylor were asked to complete the tally of votes.

Attendance Report

The Registrar, Dave Hickey, presented the attendance report and verified that we have a quorum.

There were 99 total attendees.

65 total Attendee/Observers.

34 total Official Delegates.

The total number of Community votes represented by delegates present was 59. The total number of Community votes represented by Proxy votes was <u>59</u>.
